Reporting to the Environmental Services Manager, the Painter is responsible for preparing various surfaces, drywall repair and replacement, and applying paint. RESPONSIBILITIES:

The responsibilities of a painter within the Environmental Services team include but are not limited to:

- Prioritizing work, completing assigned work orders and working independently
- Preparing work projects by assessing operational and safety risks and assembling required supplies, tools, and equipment
- Preparation of surfaces to be painted, minor drywall repairs/replacement, and additional prep work, including masking, taping, patching, caulking, sanding, scraping
- Removal of fixtures and other items from walls, set up ladders as needed.
- Perform painting tasks on walls, ceilings, trim, and other substrates.
- Apply solvent and water-based coatings using brushing and rolling
- Maintain a clean and organized job site.
- Maintain a safe working environment, adhering to safety protocols and regulations
- Collaborate with team members to complete projects efficiently and effectively
- Operate from step ladders, extension ladders (including up to 40')
